On motion of Regent Fulton the following, viz:- "Resolved that Prof. Montgomery be requested by this Board to make a professional visit to the Black Hills of Dakota, in the interests of the University. That all minerals [and symbol] other specimens fossils [and symbol] petrifications there collected and donated, be by him turned over to the Museum as the property of the University. That his salary be increased for the year 1885-6 to the extent of his actual expenses incurred in making the trip. was adopted by a unanimous affirmative vote.
