received or added thereto, to make and keep an accurate catalogue thereof, in which shall be entered the title of each, the date of its edition, and, if donated, the name of the donor, and to keep a record in which the names of all persons holding official trust in the University, and of those wearing its honors, shall be entered, as well as facts of historical interest connected with the beginning and progress of the institution

Sec. 18. The President of the University may employ two of the students of the University who who [sic] may be recommended to him by the Librarian, to take charge of the Library, and allow such student or students, such compensation as the Board may from year to year determine; provided, that the name and compensation of such assistants shall first be duly recorded by the Secretary of the Board before the term of such employment shall commence.

Sec. 19. The Librarian shall report to each annual meeting of the Board the number of volumes [in the Library, the number added during the year preceeding [sic] the report, the number of books missing, and the persons from whom due.

Sec. 20. The Board shall, at its annual meeting, make suitable appropriation for increasing the Library exclusive of text-books: All text-books shall be approved by the Board before being adopted for instruction in the University.
