Sec. 24. The several Professors of the University shall report to each annual meeting of the
[left margin] Board of Regents, the condition of the classes under their instruction, showing the kind and amount of instruction rendered during the year, with such general information and recommendations as they may deem for the interest of the University, which report shall be presented through the President. of the University, and have his endorsement thereon. The President and Faculty shall, on or before the first of October in each year, make a special and brief report of their work (omitting wants and recommendations), and transmit the same to the Secretary of the board of Regents, with a view to their embodiment in the annual report, which reports shall be presented through the President of the University.

Government.

Sec. 25. The President of the University, on consultation with the elected faculty, shall prepare
[left margin] all needful rules for the instruction and discipline of the students. All cases of suspension or dismissal of students shall be reported to the Board at its next meeting thereafter, and no student shall be expelled from the University without the assent of the Board or of the Executive Committee.

Sec. 26. In public exercises of University classes, conducted under the supervision of the
[left margin] University authorities, no discussion, either sectarian in religion or partisan in politics, shall be permitted in any manner contrary to the letter or spirit of the laws by virtue of which the
