Mr Twamley moved that the Secretary of the Faculty be instructed to win Prof John H. Hewitt of Williamstown Mass requesting him to visit Grand Forks, at our expense, for a conference with the Regents as to the Presidency of the University – which motion prevailed – Also moved that the Bills of W^m Groves, Wilson Ray, John Case – JB Johnson and Adrian Labere for work on 16th June /87 at the University be laid on the table.

Mr Fulton moved that 800 cords of mill wood be purchased of the Red River Lumber Co. at \$2²⁵ per cord delivered and that the Secretary enter into a written contract with the Company conditioned that 500[#] cords be slabs and 300 cords be “tied edging” which motion prevailed – all voting aye

Also moved. That the advertisement prepared by the Secretary of the Faculty be inserted in each of fifteen papers published in North Dakota the total expense not to exceed \$300 for three months advertising.
